'09 Recreational Soccer Program

TCSC will field a U10 Boys and a U12 girls recreational team this fall. Those teams will compete in the CESA Developmental League in Greenville. Those games are scheduled for Saturdays during the months of September and October. ALL practices will still be held at either Hurricane Park or Wren Primary.

The TCSC U6 and U8 Recreational League will begin on August 25th. On that night, ALL U6 and U8 recreational players will meet at Hurricane Park for player evaluations to be evaluated by the coaching staff in a variety of group activities and game play. These evaluations will help us to assign players to rosters evenly and maintain quality competition for the TCSC U6 and U8 program. Team assignments will be announced by August 28th. Once assigned, coaches will contact team members with team-specific details and all team practices will begin on that following Tuesday, September 1st.

'09 Fall Select Soccer Program

Fall '09 TCSC Select program consist of a U16 Girls Classic team and a U18 Girls classic team. Players were evaluated and selected to these rosters in May.

These two teams will compete in the Presidents Medal Soccer League for regular season play and then in the SCYSA Publix State Cup.

The U16's will be trained by Shannon Goodacre and Gregg Land. The U18's will be trained by Jonathan Scrivner.

Academy Soccer Program

The TCSC Academy Program has been rekindled. We have a U10 Boys team and a U10 Girls team this fall. The teams will compete in the CESA Academy League on Sunday afternoons as well as a weekend tournament or two.

The boys team will be trained by Ross Goodacre and the girls will be trained by Adriane Bevis.
